

AVAILABLE FACILITIES

The Sanctuary

The Sanctuary seats 700 people. The Georgian architectural style combines symmetry with majestic simplicity to produce a truly awe-inspiring space. Its graceful architecture, excellent acoustics, and fine pipe organ provide a beautiful setting for weddings. The church will provide upon request, candelabra (including candles), a kneeling rail and pew candles. A white cloth aisle runner is provided.

The Chapel

The Chapel is the original worship space for the church on this site. It seats approximately 100 people and is an attractive room for small or informal weddings. There is a small organ and a piano in the Chapel. The chairs in the room are movable and therefore can be varied in terms of number and arrangement.

The Atrium

The Atrium seats approximately 75 people and is occasionally used for wedding services, though the acoustics make it less than ideal. This space is often used before and after weddings as a place for fellowship and gathering. For weddings in the Chapel or Sanctuary the Atrium is set up as it normally is for Sunday mornings. These pieces of furniture remain—the four large rectangular tables, the visitor's table, the display cases, and the two small Queen Anne style tables. These are removed—card tables and stacking chairs, the nametag holder, the book cart and other extraneous items.

The Chancel

The Chancel is that portion of the Sanctuary containing the pulpit, lectern, pipe organ, and choir pews. It is appropriate for a very small wedding, providing an intimate experience in an awesome space.

The Bride's Room

This room, located under the Sanctuary, serves as a dressing room for the bride and her attendants. The room has a large mirror, high hangers for dresses, make-up counter with stools, and a restroom.

Weddings Off-site

Pastors at FCPC may officiate at weddings away from the church facility at their discretion.
